Please include the following folio requirements as part of your application:

1. A demonstration DVD (region 4), USB or digital link of you performing two musical pieces. Original songs and pieces are encouraged and please include a verbal introduction before the performance.
2. A CV/Resume with the following information included:
 - > name
 - > date of birth
 - > country of origin
 - > email address
 - > contact telephone numbers – both home and mobile
 - > any studies or courses you have undertaken related to the music industry
 - > any experiences or personal interests you have, that relate to the music industry
 - > a list of instrument (s) that you play
 - > any computer skills or music software programs you have used
 - > convenient times you are available to receive telephone calls if we need to contact you

After you submit your demonstration and CV/Resume, you will be contacted to arrange a suitable time for an interview.
