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
What is GTE?

International students applying to ECU either directly or via an approved pathway program must be genuine in their intention to study, must comply with visa requirements and must intend to return home on completion of studies. ECU are required to undertake a GTE assessment as part of the application process and the following checklist helps ensure we have all relevant documents to allow this to be completed.

Who should complete the GTE checklist?

Applicants from the following countries must submit the completed checklist and supporting documents indicated (unless agent/applicant is exempt from this requirement):



If you're not an applicant from a country listed, then you don't need to complete this document. ECU will let you know if further information or documents are needed to assist with application assessment.

Applicants may be asked to provide additional documents to verify identity.

What other information will ECU need?

As part of ECU's GTE assessment, we may contact you to discuss your application in more detail. We'll expect you to be able to explain the following:

- Your reasons for choosing ECU and the course specified in your application.
- Why you have chosen to study in Australia rather than your home country what are the differences in cost?
- How the course chosen is relevant to your future careers and educational plans.
- For previous or current employment, outline of positions held and description of duties undertaken.

ECU will also consider your ties to your home country and planned living arrangements in Australia. To assist with this you'll need to provide details of your dependants and any relatives in Australia in the table below.

Financial Capacity

As part of the GTE assessment, ECU will need to confirm that you have sufficient funds to cover the tuition fees for your proposed study together with travel and living costs for you and your accompanying family members. We will need you to confirm your source of funds at application stage and we may validate this later and request supporting evidence as part of our GTE assessment or offer acceptance process.
